The mission of JWCH Institute is to improve the health status and well being of underserved segments of the population of Los Angeles County through the direct provision or coordination of health care, health education services, and research.

JWCH is a comprehensive Medical Home delivering the highest quality health care to Los Angeles's communities, regardless of means. Through the efforts of our dedicated staff, we help keep individuals and families healthier while making our community stronger. Our passionate providers and staff deliver innovative programs tailored to each patient's needs that combine primary care, health education & prevention, chronic disease management and access to critical ancillary health and social services. Our newest clinic in Skid Row, the Center for Community Health - Downtown Los Angeles replaces our Weingart Clinic previously located in the ground floor of the Weingart Center Association. It opened on June 30, 2009, and features a full spectrum of care for the homeless, including primary care, disease management, mental health, and enabling services.

PUENTE Learning Center

PUENTE, the Spanish word for bridge, is an acronym for People United to Enrich the Neighborhood Through Education. Founded in 1989 by Sister Jennie Lechtenberg, the PUENTE Learning Center offers families the opportunity to continue their education while being given the skills necessary for the technological world of today. Approximately 2,000 students attend classes each day in Boyle Heights, with another 800 attending classes in South Los Angeles. Classes are offered in the following program areas: Pre-School Readiness, Charter Kindergarten, After School Enrichment, High School Tutorial, English as a Second Language, Spanish as a Second Language (South Los Angeles only), Adult High School Diploma, Job Training, Computer Applications, Public Speaking and Reading Academy.

Levitt Pavilion MacArthur Park

The Friends of the Levitt Pavilion MacArthur Park (LevittLA) was founded to restore the historic band shell in MacArthur Park and to establish an annual Summer Concert Season of 50 performances. MacArthur Park, just west of downtown Los Angeles, is undergoing an urban resurgence and revitalization. The park's open lawn forms a natural amphitheater with an inviting and relaxed atmosphere which lends itself to being a perfect arena for concerts. The Summer Concert Season provides a magical experience for audiences that would not have ready access to multicultural performances. Professional musicians and performing artists embody and express a rich diversity in music and dance. Over 34,000 people attended the 2008 summer concert season at MacArthur Park.
